Hurricane Irma was the first category 3 or above hurricane to reach the Florida mainland since Wilma in 2005. Like Irma, Wilma also made landfall in the greater Naples area. Unlike Wilma, Irma was a massive storm, referred as one of the biggest and strongest Atlantic Hurricanes ever to hit the United States. How do cities and counties prepare to deal with disasters like this? What efforts are undertaken to mitigate the potential damage created by such a storm, and what and why are certain recovery efforts implemented? A panel of seasoned professional local government managers in Southwest Florida will discuss these issues and more. They will cover lessons learned throughout their careers and offer specific perspectives regarding Irma.
